Leonard Angel fonds. – 1960-2013.

1.94 m of graphic and textual materials.

31 photographs (prints, b&w and colour).

Biographical Sketch

Leonard Jay Angel was born in Montreal in September 1945, and received his Bachelor of Arts from McGill University in 1966. Angel then moved to Vancouver to study at the University of British Columbia where he completed an MA in Philosophy in 1968, an MA in Creative Writing and Theatre in 1970, and a PhD in Philosophy in 1974. He was an associate fellow in UBC's Department of Philosophy in 1992, and taught philosophy at Douglas College from fall 1993 through 2012. Angel maintained a close relationship with UBC throughout his career, working on and off as a sessional lecturer for philosophy and creative writing courses, and participating in student study groups and departmental colloquia. He also produced at least two plays ("The Ballad of Etienne Brule" and "Eleanor Marx") through UBC's theatre department.

Angel was a poet, playwright, philosopher, and author, with 17 plays produced and 7 published books. He was an active figure in the Vancouver theatre scene from the 1970s through the 1990s, with plays produced and performed by Vancouver's Street Theatre, Terrific Theatre, and the New Play Centre. Angel also had several of his plays produced in theatres in Toronto and Seattle. Outside of his academic writing on philosophy, he practiced and wrote at length about Jewish theology as well as Zen practices. He was connected to Vancouver's Jewish community through his involvement in Or Shalom Synagogue and founded the Integral Studies Institute in 1987 to provide instruction on meditation and spirituality. Angel was also an advocate for World Federalism and was president of the Vancouver branch of World Federalist Movement Canada from 1996 through 2013. Leonard Angel passed away in August 2022.

Custodial History

The materials were donated in 2023 to the University Archives by Angel's widow Susan Fogel Angel.

Scope and Content

Fonds contains textual, photographic, and other graphic material related to Angel's various creative endeavors, including poetry, playwriting, prose writing, and art. Material from plays includes scripts, correspondence, clippings, and ephemera from their production. The fonds contains drafts of his poetry, as well as clippings of select poems published in the Or Shalom Synagogue's newsletter *Keren Or*. There is a wide

range of material related to Angel's scholarly and personal interests in religion, philosophy, and spirituality, including but not limited to published articles, material from meditation retreats led by Angel, and miscellaneous writing and correspondence on Judaism, Zen, and other religions and philosophies.

The fonds also contains his collected "black books," sketchbooks spanning nearly thirty years that include notes and drawings of meetings, conferences, and personal events attended by Angel. Pen and ink portraits of individuals make up the majority of Angel's sketches. Other personal records include diplomas and certificates, along with correspondence and a sample set of a card game developed by Angel.

Series Descriptions

Plays series. – 1966-1997.

20 cm of textual materials.

This series contains textual records relating to Angel's work as a playwright. It includes draft scripts, published scripts, posters, programs, newspaper clippings, and other play ephemera. Of his 17 plays produced, this series has materials related to 12 plays:

Draft material related to his monologue titled "A Poet Goes to the Dentist" can be found in the poetry series, as it was received interfiled with poetry drafts. The undated materials have been arranged alphabetically with the dated materials arranged chronologically.

Poetry series. – 1960-2000.

12 cm of textual materials.

This series includes drafts of poetry, mostly unpublished, along with clippings of the Or Shalom Synagogue's newsletter, *Keren Or*, in which some of his poetry was published. The poems in *Keren Or* are published under Leonard Angel, or his transliterated Hebrew name: Yehudah Angel, or Yehudah ben Kalam v'Esther. Much of his unpublished poetry is undated. This series also contains drafts of Angel's produced monologue, "A Poet Goes to the Dentist." The materials have been arranged alphabetically by subject.

Philosophy and spirituality series. – 1962-2010.

12.5 cm of textual materials.

This series contains material related to Angel's academic pursuits and personal interests in religion, spirituality, mysticism, and philosophy. Material includes essays, academic journal publications, correspondence, posters, pamphlets, artwork, annotated Hebrew commentaries, and other ephemera. The materials have been arranged alphabetically by subject.

Two files from this series, "Crossways and the Gathering" and [Literally?] and Jesus Genealogy, were removed for conservation treatment before processing was complete and filed at the end of Box 1 when reintegrated.

Personal records series. – 1966-2013.

12 cm of textual materials.

This series includes textual records relating to Angel's personal life and endeavors. It consists of diplomas for his academic degrees, material from his unfinished and unpublished memoir, samples and correspondence related to his card game "Flip Deck," proceedings from a Vancouver trial where he served as defendant, and a certificate of his wife's conversion to Judaism. The materials have been arranged alphabetically by subject.

Sketchbooks series. – 1980-2007.

1.37 m of graphic and textual materials (51 sketchbooks).

This series consists of Angel's "black books," sketchbooks that were used as journals of his daily life. Handwritten notes and pen and ink drawings comprise the majority of their content. His notes document rehearsals for his plays, early designs for his card game, and people and landscapes in his personal life. Many drawings of individuals are identified as participants in conferences, meetings, and events attended by Angel; some of these include Or Shalom meetings, philosophy talks and conferences, and World Federalist events and talks. Some, but not all sketchbooks include a list of identified individuals and locations on their final page. Several journals contain pamphlets, programs, and other ephemera interfiled between pages. Journals have been arranged chronologically.

Photographs series. – 1980-1983.

31 photographs (b&w and colour).

This series contains one photograph of Angel's artwork, two publicity shots of Angel, photographs of *The Unveiling* production, and photographs of two sesshin, one led by Kyozan Joshu Sasaki (1907–2014). The photo of Angel's artwork was found loose with his sketchbooks. The publicity shots and The Unveiling production photographs were

included with File 1-15 in an envelope labelled "Unveiling Photos." The sesshin photographs were included with File 2-4 in an envelope addressed to "Toby."
